

**ARTICULATION AGREEMENT  
BETWEEN  
BETHEL UNIVERSITY  
AND  
CONCORDE CAREER COLLEGE**

This Articulation Agreement is entered into by and among **Bethel University** and **Concorde Career College** for the purpose of providing a seamless opportunity for students to strengthen valid education endeavors.

**Whereas, Bethel University** is a Christian liberal arts university accredited by the Commission on Colleges of the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools, granting bachelor's and master's degrees; and

**Whereas, Concorde Career College** is a private, for-profit, two-year college accredited by the Commission of the Council on Occupational Education, granting Associate of Applied Science degrees and

**Whereas,** it is the expressed desire of both institutions to expand educational opportunities available to the students of **Concorde Career College** and to extend mutual cooperative efforts for students to progress toward bachelor degrees attained at **Bethel University**. Students transferring between institutions must be in good standing at their home institution and have a grade point average equal to that required for retention at the receiving institution. Credit granted for transfer courses will be based on evaluation of official transcripts issued directly by the credit-granting institution. **Bethel University** will accept up to eighty (80) semester credit hours for students transferring from **Concorde Career College**. No distinction will be made between on-site courses and distance education courses by either institution as long as those courses conform to established standards for all courses at the offering institution. The chief academic officers or their designees will confer at least once per year about course offerings at the institutions.

Attached is an approved program of study which would lead to an Associate of Applied Science degree from **Concorde Career College** and would allow a student with a minimum GPA of 2.0 to enter on a space available basis with junior standing at **Bethel University** and to complete the bachelor degree in Science with a concentration in Management and Organizational Development or Organizational Leadership.

This articulation agreement will be in effect for five (5) years upon the affixing of the signatures of the presidents of the two institutions. Renewal of the agreement will be discussed at the end of this time period. The agreement is subject to the policies and regulations of the boards and agencies that have oversight of the respective institutions and may be terminated by either party with a ninety (90) day written notification. Such termination will not affect students enrolled in either institution under the agreement at the time of termination or expiration. A student will have at least six (6) years to complete the coursework and transfer under this agreement to Bethel University.

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NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that both institutions agree to the following:

**Concorde Career College** agrees to assist and advise **Concorde Career College** full and part-time students who desire to continue their studies toward the achievement of bachelor degrees at **Bethel University**.

**Bethel University** agrees to accept all credit generated by **Concorde Career College** in accordance with the attached agenda.

**Bethel University** and **Concorde Career College** mutually agree to periodically review the attached program articulation agreement and to update and maintain them in keeping with current curricular requirements.
